

EDUCATION HOLDS THE KEYS TO SUCCESS

Assemblyman Andy Goodell has fought hard for our children because he knows a solid education is critical for employment and career success. This year he:

- Helped secure an operating aid increase of 5.3% for Chautauqua County schools, which is higher than the statewide average. Every school district in Chautauqua County received an increase in classroom based aid;
- Supported an expansion of high-speed Internet access to public libraries through a partnership between the local libraries and BOCES;
- Voted to support the Higher Education Opportunity Program (HEOP) so that college is an option for every child; and
- Provided additional funding for improvements to the SUNY system, including an increase of \$150 per student in financial aid for JCC.

Andy Goodell understands that there are real challenges facing our schools and local taxpayers. That is why he:

- Supports legislation allowing school districts to form a regional high school,
- Opposes efforts to impose burdensome regulatory requirements on our schools; and
- Supports efforts to improve school attendance and graduation rates.
