




# 2014 Community Outreach Survey Results

## JOB CREATION

Would you vote to eliminate business incentive programs and use the savings to cut taxes for all businesses?


**Yes 65%**

## HEALTH CARE

Would you vote to allow small businesses to offer a very basic health insurance policy to reduce health insurance costs?


**Yes 88%**

**No 80%**




**Assemblyman Goodell voted AGAINST A-8070, which would have expanded availability of late term abortions up until natural birth.**



## WELFARE REFORM

Would you vote to include all the income of both parents in calculating the welfare eligibility, regardless of marital status?


**Yes 94%**  
**No 6%**



## CAMPAIGN FINANCE

Would you vote to provide taxpayer funding for political campaigns?

**Yes 14.8%**  
**No 85.2%**



**Andy Goodell voted against Assembly Bill 4980-D, which would have cost hundreds of millions in taxpayer dollars for political campaigns.**

## 2014 Survey Snapshot

55%

55% of Chautauqua County residents support increasing funds for roads and bridges.

*The 2014-15 State Budget includes \$478.1 million for road and bridge repairs.*

94%

94% support reducing welfare benefits to the national average after recipients have been on welfare for 5 years.

*Andy Goodell is a leading voice for welfare reform in the state Assembly, and has introduced several bills for welfare reform.*

71%

71% support hydraulic fracturing for natural gas with strict environmental regulations.

98%

98% support limiting food stamps to healthy food and prohibiting beneficiaries of food stamps from purchasing snacks, soft drinks or junk food.
