Supervised by the Nassau County Police Department, join us to dispose of unwanted or expired medication and to shred your documents. Disposing of medication improperly, such as flushing it down a toilet or pouring it down the drain, can lead to pollution in the water we use for drinking, cooking, and bathing. Safe disposal helps protect our health and keeps prescription drugs away from young children or others who might use them improperly. Additionally, throwing out or recycling sensitive paperwork without shredding it first can lead to identity theft.

Healthcare Fraud Seminar

Assemblyman Ed Ra and LiveOn New York hosted a Healthcare Fraud Seminar in April 2018 at the Mineola Memorial Library. At the seminar, John Rotondi, a certified senior medicare patrol educator, spoke about healthcare fraud and how to avoid it. Topics included how to spot potential fraud, medicare cards rollout, scams and frauds related to Medicare cards, and how to protect yourself from these scams and frauds. LEGISLATION

Assemblyman Ra has also fought in Albany for a better quality of life for seniors to enjoy their golden years to the fullest. This included supporting bills which would:

- Increase the income cap level to \$100,000 for senior citizens who are applying for the Enhanced STAR property tax exemption. (A.5853)
- Create a fixed real property school tax rate for seniors who are 70 and older, own property, and who are qualified for the Enhanced STAR tax exemption. (A.2533)
- Increase mobility for seniors by creating a pilot program for on demand transit service. (A.8229)
