Paid Family Leave starts Jan. 1

Assemblymember Steck: Family comes first

New York's paid family leave program takes effect Jan. 1, offering paid time off for employees to care for a new child or sick relative and for those with relatives on active military duty.



The program offers:

- ✓ paid time off for 8 weeks in 2018, increasing to 12 weeks by 2021
- ✓ continuation of employee's health insurance while on paid family leave
- ✓ job protection upon return
