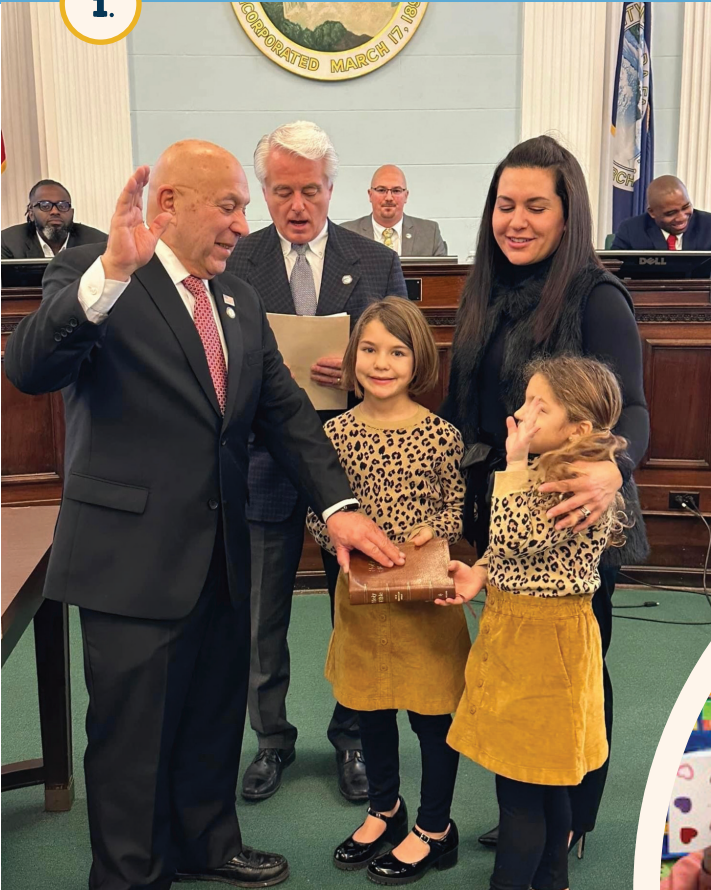

3. I fought against the 'Raise the Age' (RTA) law, which went into effect in 2018^{1,2}, increasing the age for youth who can be prosecuted as an adult from 16 to 18 years of age. RTA allows 16- and 17- year-old adolescent offenders who commit serious felonies to avoid criminal liability³ by being transferred to family court, where records remain sealed^{4,5} even after they are of legal age, thereby preventing some youth offenders from facing criminal court.

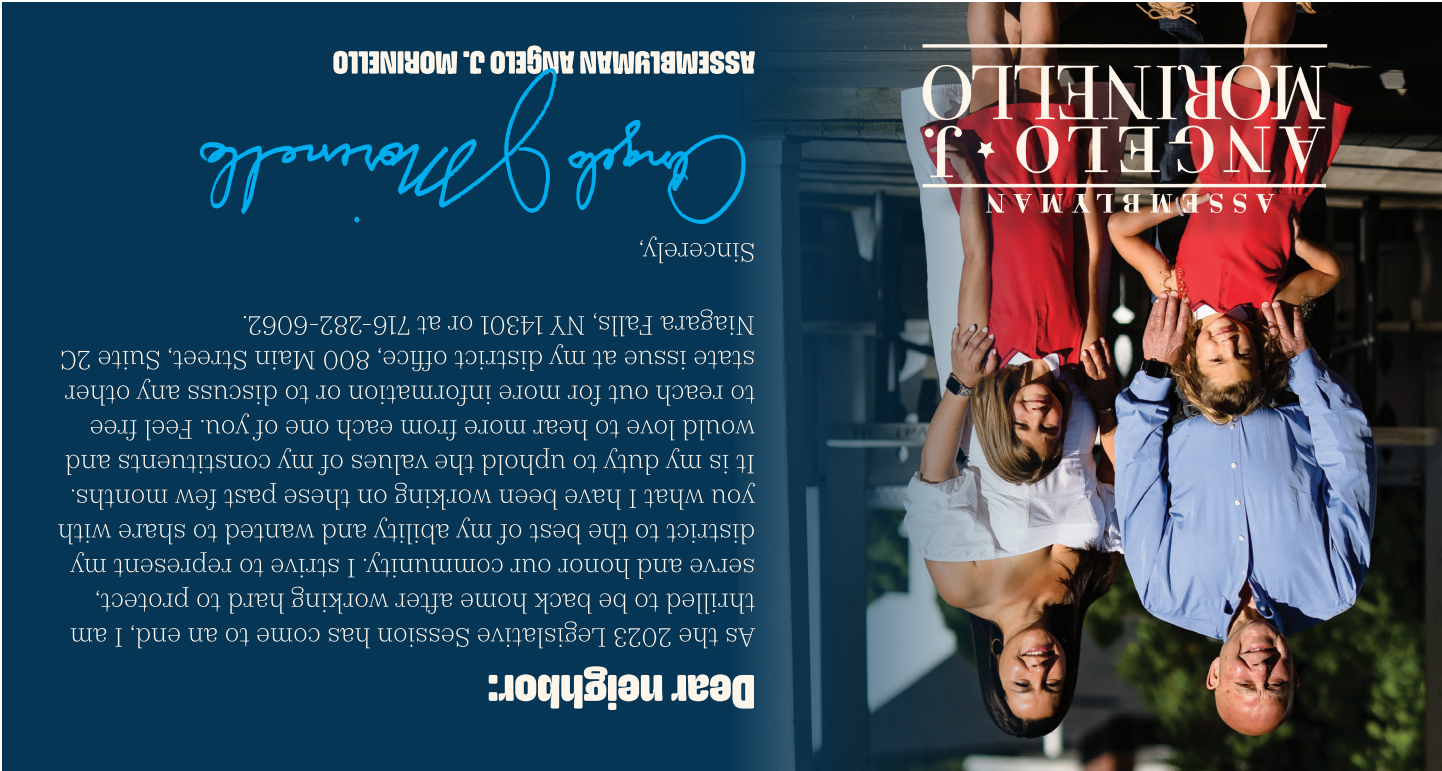

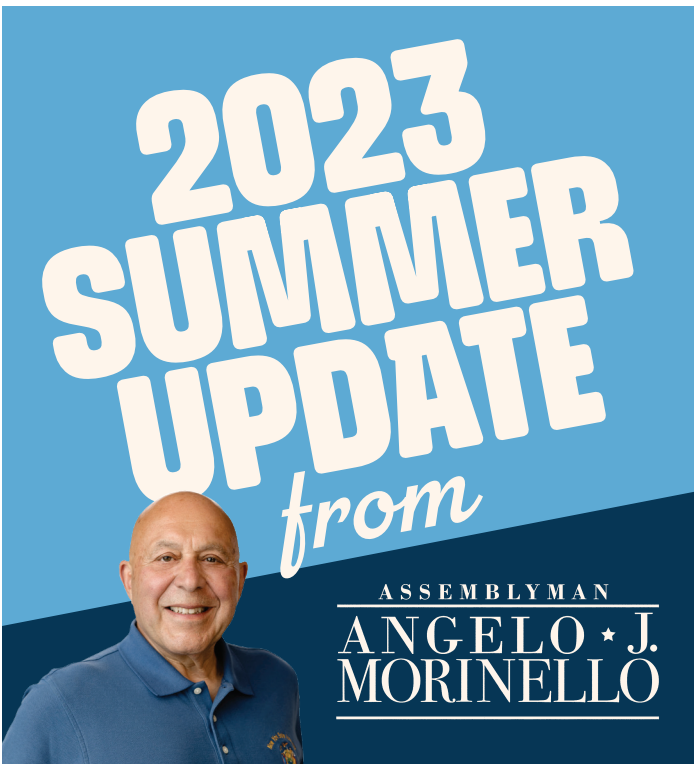
