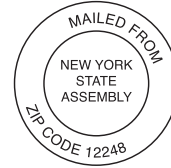

That is why I have actively endorsed legislation aimed at recognizing and honoring these dedicated heroes.

#### **IN THE ASSEMBLY:**

- ★ Support the expansion of tuition aid for Gold Star Families.
- ★ Support making it easier for veterans to secure low interest and low down payment mortgages. (A.2066 of 2023)
- ★ Support the establishment of July 16th as a day of commemoration known as "Atomic and Nuclear Veterans Day." (A.2322 of 2023)
- ★ Support the establishment of the Veterans Memorials Preservation Act. (A.3658)
- ★ Co-sponsor legislation that requires the Division of Military and Naval Affairs to establish policies to ensure the security and protection of Air National Guard Recruiting Centers as well as ROTC facilities. (A.4206 of 2023)
- ★ Helped increase resources to aid veterans struggling with mental health and addiction. (A.8728 of 2022)
- ★ Supported the creation and expansion of the Women's Veterans Advisory Committee. (A.1140-A of 2021/A.8731 of 2022)
- ★ Supported the proposal of foreign-born family members of New York veterans securing their citizenship. (A.4660-A of 2022)
- ★ Helped grant additional recognition for members who served in Vietnam and Korea. (A.357 of 2022/A.1310 of 2022)
