#### LEGISLATIVE ACTION

The Legislature appropriates \$2,050,796,433 on an All Funds basis, a decrease of \$27,300,000 from the Executive budget submission.

#### **Legislative Reductions**

The Legislature reduces non-personal service and maintenance undistributed appropriations by \$10,000,000.

The Legislature reduces the appropriation for pension costs by \$17,300,000, which is related to the amortization of those costs.

#### Article VII

The Legislature accepts the Executive proposal to provide quarterly, rather than annual payments to the Office of Court Administration (OCA) Indigent Legal Services.

The Legislature rejects the Executive proposal to allow tort action awards against municipalities and the State to be offset by the expectation of the receipt of future collateral source payments.

The Legislature rejects the Executive proposal to mandate that claims against certain public corporations be brought exclusively in the Court of Claims.

The Legislature rejects the Executive proposal to allow for business records to be presented as evidence in grand jury proceedings via affidavit.
