

Soating Safety

Brianna's Law mandates all motorboat operators, regardless of age, will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2025.

DO YOU NEED A BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE?

MOTORBOATS

Under the new law, all motorboat operators:

- Born on or after Jan. 1, 1978, will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2024
- All motorboat operators regardless of age will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2025

PERSONAL WATERCRAFT

Anyone operating a Personal Watercraft (JetSki™, WaveRunner™, etc.) must have a boating safety certificate and be at least 14 years of age or older

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS



Federal law dictates disposable fire extinguishers are considered expired 12 years after the manufacture date stamped on the extinguisher. Additionally, you may see changes on fire extinguisher labels.

WHAT WAS KNOWN AS:

AND EQUIVALENT TO:

B-I extinguisher

Type 5-B or 10-B extinguisher

IS NOW KNOWN AS.

B-II

Type 20-B extinguisher

Boats less than 26 feet in length and model year 2018 or newer must carry extinguishers bearing the new label effective April 20, 2022. Boats model year 2017 or later may continue to carry extinguishers with the old labels until they expire. The current legislation does not have the B-I & B-II grandfathering clause. NYS will allow all extinguishers until they are 12 years from manufacture, regardless of marking.

ENGINE CUT-OFF SWITCH (ECOS):

If a vessel less than 26 feet is equipped with an engine cut-off switch, the operator of the vessel is required to use it and the associated lanyard attached to the operator. As of 2018, all newly manufactured boats are required to have an ECOS installed.

SOUND-SIGNALING DEVICES ABOARD PADDLE CRAFT:

All paddle craft users must carry a sound-signaling device aboard. A mouth whistle fulfills this requirement.
