TEAL ALERT WILL SAVE LIVES.

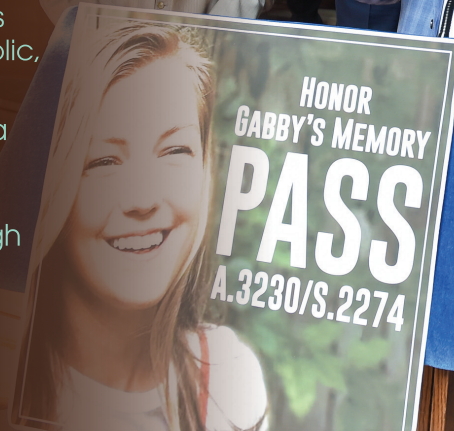
In tribute to **Gabby Petito**, a 22-year-old from Long Island, I continue to advocate for the establishment of a “**Teal Alert**” system.

 It would address the **disappearance of adults aged 18 to 64**, including those facing **domestic violence threats**.

 It's modeled after the **Amber Alert** for missing children and the **Silver Alert** for seniors and adults with mental health concerns.

 **Teal Alert** would swiftly broadcast relevant details about the individual's disappearance to the public, facilitating prompt assistance.

While Gabby Petito's case isn't the first instance of a missing adult and domestic violence victim, it has brought crucial attention to this issue nationwide. New York must join the national alert network through the enactment of “**Gabby's Law**” through the passage of A.3230.
