What was accomplished during the 2021 Legislative Session?



It has truly been an honor to serve as your voice in the Assembly this past year. I'm proud of the work we have accomplished that helped us move ahead during the pandemic. I look forward to getting back to work in Albany to fight for our values.

What I SUPPORTED:

- ✓ Requiring hospitals to establish clinical staffing committees to ensure proper care for residents and patients. (A.108-B)
- ✓ Securing \$538.1 million in CHIPS funding to repair, repave, and rebuild local roads and bridges. (A.3004-D)
- ✓ Protecting our police by strengthening penalties for individuals who cause harm to police or peace officers in the line of duty. (A.6578)

What I voted AGAINST:

- ✗ Restoring voting rights for individuals who were released with a felony conviction. (A.4448-A)
- ✗ A \$2.1 billion fund which sent unemployment checks to undocumented immigrants. The checks were up to \$15,600. (A.3009-C) (A.3003-C)
- ✗ Raising taxes by \$8.1 billion. (A.3009-C).
