Assemblywoman Jean-Pierre is *standing up* for Long Island families

Paid family leave took effect Jan. 1 and offers:

- ***Paid leave*** for employees with a new child, sick relative or family member on active military duty
- ***8 weeks*** of paid leave, increasing to ***12 weeks*** by 2021
- ***Job protection*** and ***continuation of health insurance*** while on leave

New York's minimum wage also increased on Dec. 31. Here's what you need to know:

- Suffolk County now has a minimum wage of ***\$11 per hour***
- The minimum wage will increase by \$1 annually until it reaches ***\$15 per hour***
