- Passed commonsense gun safety measures, including establishing an extreme risk protection order to better protect our families (Ch. 19, 129, 130 and 135 of 2019)
- Made the 2% property tax cap permanent to help homeowners keep more of their hard-earned money (Ch. 58 of 2019)
- Implemented a plan to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, achieve New York's renewable energy goals by 2030 and promote environmental justice (Ch. 106 of 2019)

- Provided an additional \$500 million to protect access to clean water statewide (Ch. 58 of 2019)
- Banned most single-use plastic bags given out by grocery stores and other retailers (Ch. 58 of 2019)
- Passed comprehensive voting reforms, including early voting, to ensure every New Yorker's voice is heard (Ch. 2, 3, 4 and 6 of 2019, A.777, A.778)

- Passed the Child Victims Act to give victims of childhood sexual abuse more time to seek justice (Ch. 11 of 2019)

- Passed Shannon's Law to require insurance companies to cover annual mammogram screenings for women ages 35 to 39 (Ch. 143 of 2019)
