The 2022-23 state budget provides:

- \$2.2 billion for property tax rebate checks
- \$585 million to suspend the state gas tax through the end of the year
- \$475 million for an additional Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit payment
- \$250 million to help New Yorkers catch up on utility bills
- \$162 million to accelerate middle-class tax cuts

IMPORTANT UPDATE ON FUEL COST IN THE STATE:

Effective Wednesday June 1, 2022, NYS has suspended the Motor Fuel Excise Tax, Sales Tax, and Metropolitan Commuter Transportation District Sales Tax on motor fuel and diesel through the end of the year. This fuel taxes suspension will provide a reduction of at least \$0.16 per gallon Statewide, with some counties providing additional savings per gallon.
