## THE DSA ACT WOULD:

- Require sensitivity training for students, faculty and staff conducted by an expert in the areas of antisemitism awareness, prevention and Jewish culture and history
- Establish baseline reporting requirements for colleges to combat a growing, unsettling rise in antisemitism
- Publicize information regarding who to contact with questions regarding the DSA Act
- Require colleges to record and report the number of incidents of antisemitism that occur on campuses annually
- Enforce state aid penalties for failing to comply with these requirements
