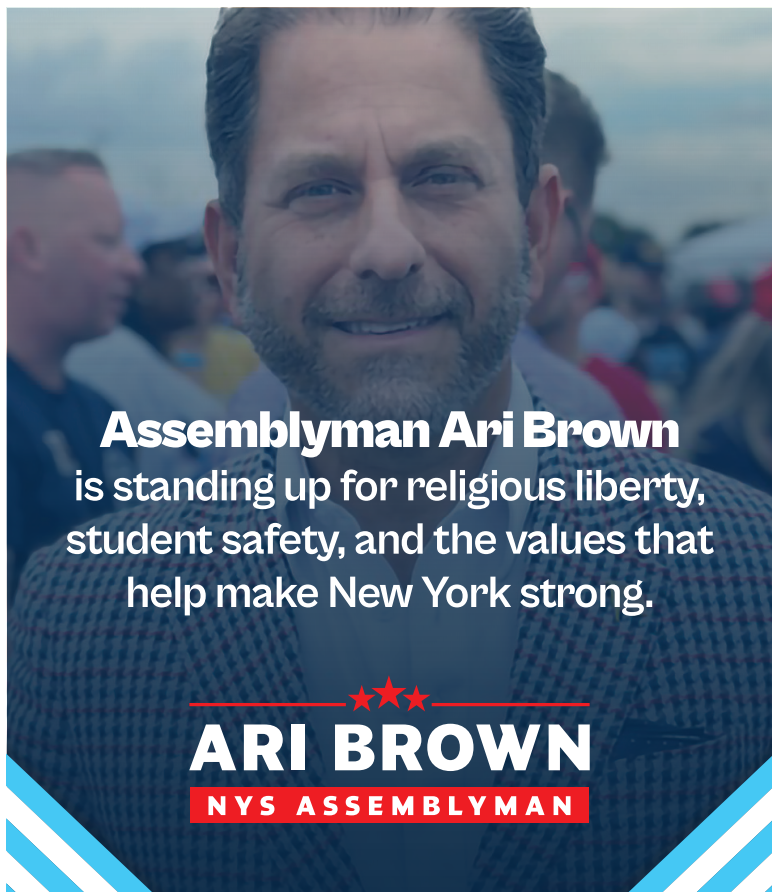




Antisemitism is **not just a Jewish issue.** It is an attack on the principles of religious freedom, equality and respect that define our nation.

HOW I CONTINUE TO FIGHT ANTISEMITISM

- Co-sponsored the Honoring Our Pledge to Eliminate Antisemitism (HOPE) Act (A.2139A)
- Introduced legislation prohibiting tuition assistance for students who knowingly engage in certain antisemitic activities (A.4772)
- Introduced the Stop Antisemitism on College Campuses Act to ensure taxpayer-funded institutions are held accountable for supporting antisemitic events (A.4797)
- Introduced legislation establishing October 7 Remembrance Day to honor victims and strengthen antisemitism education statewide (A.6557)

Additional Legislation to Protect Students, Families and Communities

Campus Accountability and Student Safety

A.4813: Prohibits state funding for colleges and universities that permit foreign terrorist organizations or activities in support of foreign terrorist organizations on campus.

A.4809: Establishes penalties, including tuition assistance consequences, for individuals found guilty of antisemitic acts.

A.7549: Creates the Degree Integrity and Accountability Act to hold students accountable for violent criminal conduct, support for terrorism and serious misconduct.

Public Safety and Community Protection

A.4766: Requires arrests when law enforcement has reasonable cause to believe a hate crime has been committed.

A.4773: Addresses masked intimidation by prohibiting organized groups from concealing their identities.

A.4968: Expands Good Samaritan protections for individuals who intervene to protect others and supports public education efforts on community safety.
