- ✓ **\$150 million** in funding for the New York Housing for the Future Rental and Co-Op Programs
- ✓ **\$140 million** in funding for NYCHA capital projects and improvements
- ✓ **\$2.53 million** for a new park at NYCHA's Pomonok Houses

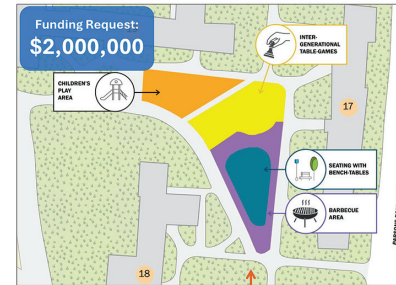

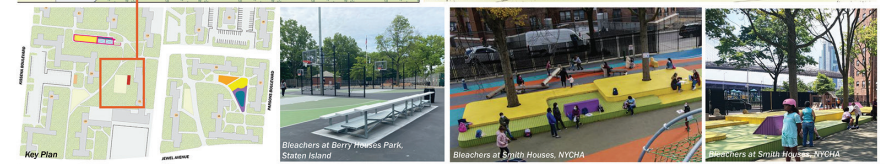
