Passed **comprehensive election reforms**, including:

- Establish early voting, which would take place during a nine-day period before elections (Ch. 6 of 2019)
- Allow everyone to vote by absentee ballot (A.778)
- Combine the state and federal primary days (Ch. 5 of 2019)
- Ensure voter registration is automatically transferred to your new county when you move (Ch. 3 of 2019)
- Allow everyone to vote by absentee ballot (A.778)



Turned the **Jose Peralta New York State DREAM Act** into reality to help the children of immigrants achieve their college dreams (A.782)



Made the **Child Victims Act** law so childhood sexual abuse victims can seek justice and hold abusers accountable (Ch. 11 of 2019)



Passed commonsense measures, including establishing an extreme risk protection order, to **prevent senseless gun violence** (Ch. 19 of 2019, A.2684, A.2686-A, A.2690)



Increased fairness in New York's criminal justice system by reforming cash bail, ensuring speedy trials, and revamping the discovery process (A.2009-C)



Protecting our environment now, and for future generations by:

- Increasing the state's historic investment in clean water to \$3 billion to address emerging contaminants, replace lead drinking water service lines, and repair aging water mains and sewer lines, and
- Lowering the threshold for elevated blood lead levels to protect children from lead poisoning
