Victory for NYC Retirees on Medicare

Last week a State Supreme Court judge ruled that New York City is not allowed to switch retirees who have worked for the municipal government over to a Medicare Advantage plan. The City's original plan would have changed municipal retiree's healthcare plans from public to private, raising their personal costs and restricting their coverage. I was an early advocate against the City's misguided plan and am proud to have stood with the retirees throughout their struggle.
