- Expanded access to quality, affordable child care to help parents balance work and family
- Secured \$600 million over 2 years for full-day UPK to help give kids a solid start to their education
- Increased NYC school aid by \$435
 million to help ensure every student gets a
 first-class education

 Making college more affordable
 by increasing funding for the Tuiti
- Reformed Common Core to address parents' concerns and alleviate the stress on students
- A \$2 billion bond act to help replace classroom trailers with permanent space, construct new pre-K classrooms and improve technology
 - Making college more affordable by increasing funding for the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) and other college opportunity programs



- \$350 tax rebate checks for families with children
- Cut an energy tax on residents and businesses, saving \$600 million over 3 years
- Expanded the NY Youth Works program, providing up to \$5,000 in tax credits for businesses that hire unemployed youth, ages 16-24
- Tax credits for renters and co-op and condo owners through a "circuit breaker," which bases taxes on ability to pay
- Expanded the Senior Citizen Rent Increase Exemption (SCRIE) program to help seniors afford to stay in their homes
