School Backpack Giveaway!



The role of the ship is to assist approximately 400 cadets who chose to participate in the SUNY Maritime Cadet Program, obtain hands-on experience while conducting training, and learn in a safe and simulated environment. The Assemblyman and interns joined the ship as it weighed anchor and completed the last leg of its 2-month voyage. As the ship sailed underneath the Throgs Neck Bridge to return to port at SUNY Maritime College in the Bronx, the cadets' family members began to cheer in anticipation of the ships arrival. This hour-long excursion gave the Assemblyman (a proud graduate of SUNY Maritime College) enough time to give his staffers a tour of the 10 levels of the ship including the bridge, engine room, and the ship's cafeteria. Free Covid-19 Tests!

Every U.S household is eligible to order 4 free at-home tests. Call 800-232-0233 or go to covidtest.gov to place your order.

Reminder: Beginning November 12, 2024, all properties with 1-9 residential units will be required to use bins (55 gallons or less), with secure lids to set out trash.

You can use a compliant bin (55 gallons or less with a secure lid) that you already have, but starting June 2026, you MUST use an official NYC Bin. Order by October 1st to ensure delivery by November 12! Official NYC Bins are only available for purchase online at: www.bins.nyc or scan the Qr-code below.
