# Assemblymember Stefani L. Zinerman: Helping make Brooklyn a better place to live and call home

## Improving Access to Child Care



Access to reliable, affordable child care is vital for families to thrive.

- ◆ Assemblymember Zinerman helped pass a law (Ch. 694 of 2022) aimed at **increasing access to state child care assistance** for low-income, homeless, and struggling families. The legislation helps families who are working part-time, participating in educational or vocational studies, or have rotating schedules.
- ◆ Assemblymember Zinerman backed legislation (A.7093 of 2022) to **remove work requirements for individuals receiving a child care subsidy** if they are enrolled in an educational program.

## Advancing Minority- and Women-Owned Business Enterprises (MBWE)



Actively supporting initiatives to expand opportunities for minority and women-owned businesses (MWBE) to access government contracts and foster their growth.

- ◆ She is co-sponsoring legislation (A.3963) aimed at addressing inequities faced by MWBEs by mandating that state contractors and subcontractors allocate a fair share of contracts to these enterprises.
- ◆ Assemblymember Zinerman is co-sponsoring a bill (A.1266) that would require contractors to communicate with and provide clear timeframes for work assignments and payments to MWBEs listed on the contractor's utilization plan for a state contract.

## Protecting Women and Children



- ◆ Assemblymember Zinerman supported legislation (Ch. 732 of 2023) establishing a task force to develop **policy changes addressing the inequities and improper investigation of missing and murdered Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC)**.
  - ◇ The legislation aims to ensure that missing BIPOC women and girls receive the same level of respect, time, and effort in investigations as others, making equitable treatment a top priority for the state.
- ◆ She is co-sponsoring "Kyra's Law" (A.3346-B), aimed at safeguarding children from dangerous custody situations.
  - ◇ This legislation mandates court decisions to prioritize a child's health and safety in custody and visitation determinations, addressing systemic weaknesses in existing law and prioritizing the safety of children above all else, preventing abuse and tragedy.
