## **Safer Businesses**

Reilly successfully advocated for legislative action to combat the rise in serial shoplifting and organized retail theft. For the first time ever, prosecutors are allowed to combine the value of items stolen through a common scheme or plan and charge individuals responsible with grand larceny<sup>5</sup>.
