



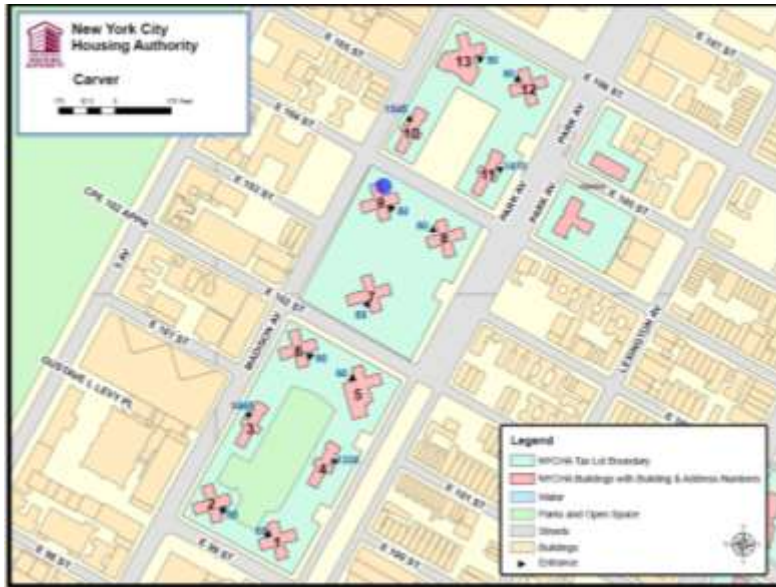
THE 68TH DISTRICT NYCHA TRACKER REPORT

The 68th Assembly District has the highest concentration of public housing in the State, with 20 developments spanning across three miles of urban city blocks. Many times during the winter months, our New York City Housing Authority residents experience serious interruptions in heat and hot water services. As we continue to monitor NYCHA to ensure that they are providing safe and adequate housing, I am introducing a new NYCHA Tracker.

NYCHA Tracker is a report to the people of East Harlem of heat and hot water service interruptions in the 68th Assembly District. The data is based solely on direct reports of interruptions from NYCHA residents and Tenant Associations communicated to my office. A hot water interruption was reported at 50 East 104th Street on 2/20/19, the NYCHA residence also complained that water pressure was very low.



Lexington Houses

There was hot water service interruption reported at 110 East 99th Street on 2/21/19. The complainant reported that the problem is ongoing, service is restored and then shortly after the hot water goes out again.
