
#### THE 68TH DISTRICT NYCHA TRACKER REPORT

The 68th Assembly District has the highest concentration of public of housing in the State, with 20 developments spanning across three miles of urban city blocks. Many times during the winter months, our New York City Housing Authority residents experience serious interruptions in heat and hot water services. As we continue to monitor NYCHA to ensure that they are providing safe and adequate housing, I am introducing a new NYCHA Tracker.

NYCHA Tracker is a report to the people of East Harlem of heat and hot water service interruptions in the 68th Assembly District. The data is based solely on direct reports of interruptions from NYCHA residents and Tenant Associations communicated to my office. 

#### **Carver Houses**

A heat interruption was reported at 1465 Madison Avenue on 2/22/19, the NYCHA residence reported that interruptions generally take 4-7 days for NYCHA resolve. As of 3/4/19, the NYCHA website indicated there was no service interruption at this location.






# **Washington Houses**

There was hot water service interruption reported at 1895 East 96<sup>th</sup> Street on 3/1/19. The complainant reported that the problem is ongoing.



#### **Holmes Towers**

There have been ongoing hot water outages at Holmes Towers building 2, located at 405 East 92<sup>nd</sup> Street. Our records show that hot water had not been restored on 2/28/19. While the NYCHA service interruption website reported that service was restored, another interruption occurred on 3/1/19. NYCHA reported that service was again restored yet another outage was reported on 3/4/19 and on 3/5/19. We will continue to monitor this interruption as the outage affects 273 units and 471 Holmes residents.



# **Taft Houses**

A hot water outage was reported on 3/1/19 at 1694 Madison Avenue. The NYCHA service interruption website indicated that this outage affected 150 units and 280 residents. As of 3/4/19, the website indicated there was no service interruption.
