

THE 68TH DISTRICT NYCHA TRACKER REPORT

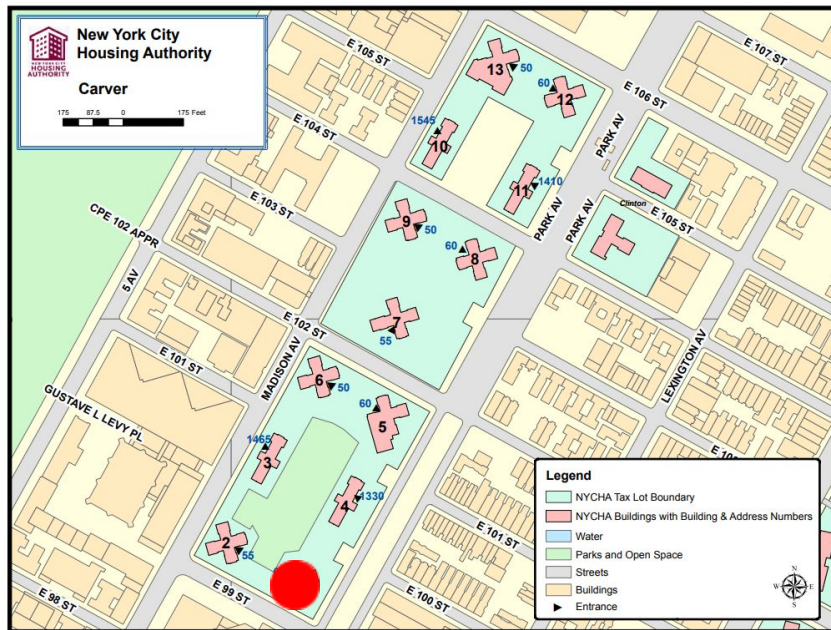
The 68th Assembly District has the highest concentration of public of housing in the State, with 20 developments spanning across three miles of urban city blocks. Many times during the winter months, our New York City Housing Authority residents experience serious interruptions in heat and hot water services. As we continue to monitor NYCHA to ensure that they are providing safe and adequate housing, I am introducing a new NYCHA Tracker.

NYCHA Tracker is a report to the people of East Harlem of heat and hot water service interruptions in the 68th Assembly District. The data is based solely on direct reports of interruptions from NYCHA residents and Tenant Associations communicated to my office. Carver Houses

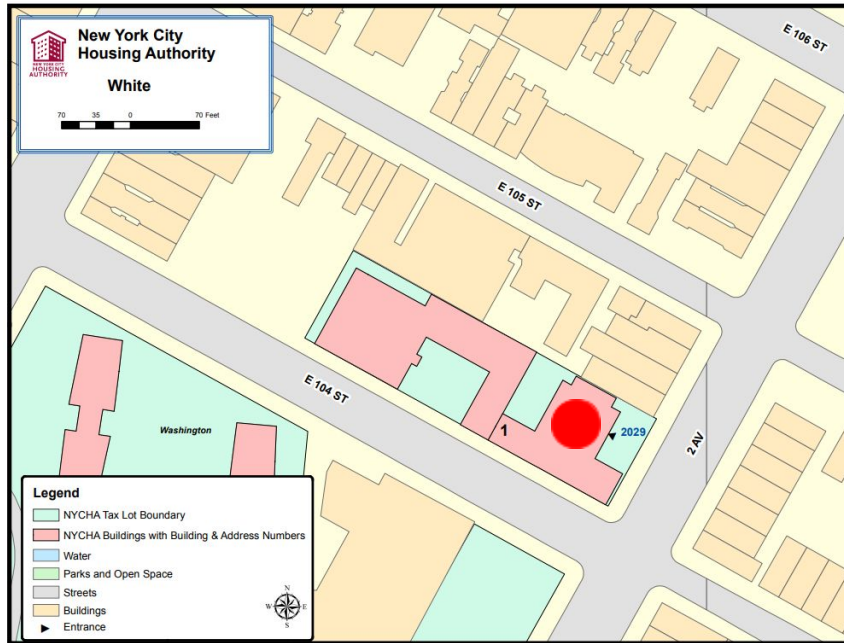
A heat and hot water interruption was reported at 65 East 99th on 4/24/19. Service was restored 48 hours later on 4/26/19. As of 4/29/19, the NYCHA website indicated there was no service interruption at this location. However, we have been notified by tenants that rainy weather causes the boiler to shut down for days at a time. Our office will follow up with NYCHA.

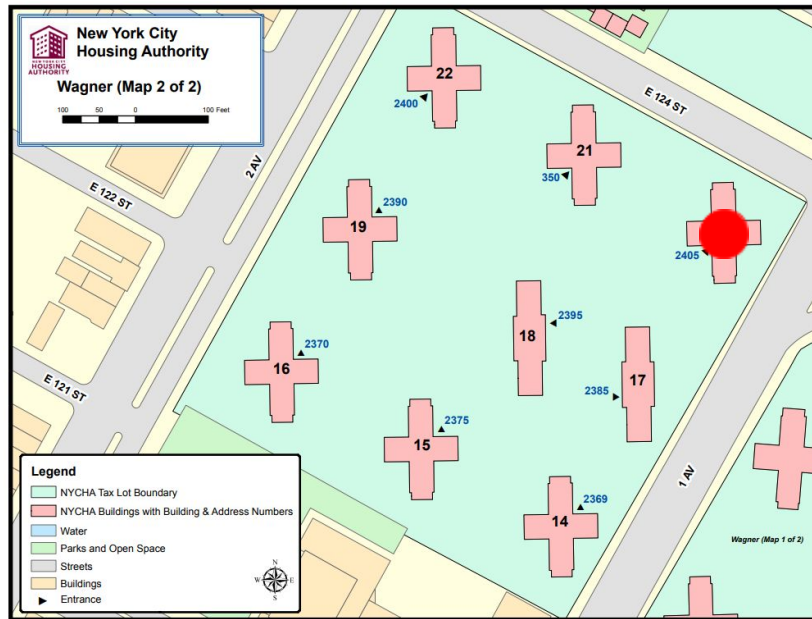
Gaylord White Houses

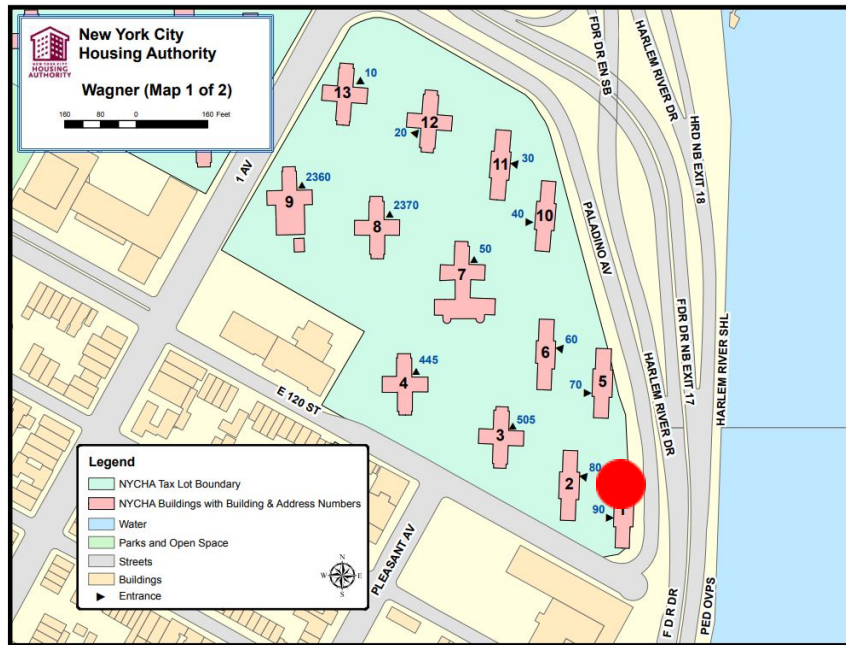


Wagner Houses
