Last year, our office set up a NYCHA Heat and Hot Water Tracker to track of heat and hot water outages in our NYCHA communities. As the Assembly Member for the 68th Assembly District, which has the highest concentration of public of housing in the State, I am committed to ensuring our communities complaints and concerns are not just heard but are addressed.

Our neighbors have experienced serious interruptions in heat and hot water services and my team has worked tirelessly to assist in expediting complaints made to NYCHA. As we say goodbye to the winter and welcome the spring and summer, we are sharing our final outage report.

While May 31st is the official end of the "heat" season please remember, that landlords are required to provide hot water year-round. Please continue to reach out to my office if you experience hot water outages or other repair issues in your apartment or building.


NYCHA TRACKER REPORT April 30, 2019 - May 31, 2019

Gaylord White Houses

Heat and hot water interruptions were reported at 2029 2nd Avenue on 5/11, 5/12 & 5/15. There was intermittent service through the week. Service was fully restored by 5/15.


Again, on 5/20-5/26, the building tenants

experienced intermittent hot water service. Normal service has been restored since 5/27 and the NYCHA website indicated there was no service interruption at this location. We will follow-up with NYCHA about this chronic hot water issue.




Clinton Houses

Hot water interruptions were reported at 1505 Park Avenue on 5/30. As of 5/30/19, the NYCHA website indicated there was a service outage that they are currently working on restoration.



Johnson Houses

Hot water interruptions were reported at 1581 Park Avenue on 5/29. As of 5/30/19, the NYCHA website indicated there was a service outage that they have since address it.
