Only have minutes to spare? Here's what you need to know:

- Introduced legislation requiring companies whose employees or contractors ride e-bikes or escooters to administer a safety course on the rules of the road, and to penalize companies who fail to do so. This will help protect both pedestrians and riders.
- Spoke out against antisemitism after the Kehilath Jeshurun (KJ) Synagogue on 85th St was vandalized. There is no place in New York for vitriol and violence against Jews, and we will not be complacent in the face of hatred and ignorance.
- Supporting Workers: this past month, I met with the National Labor Caucus and supported local Starbucks workers as they fight for their right to unionize.
