Only have minutes to spare? Here's what you need to know:



The Assemblymember participated in several discussions on Artificial Intelligence (AI) and its rapid development. Alex is the first elected member of his party in NY to have a degree in computer science, and has academic and professional experience in AI.

At **Temple Emanu-El** (top), **Cornell Tech** (left), and at the **NewDEAL Leaders Conference** (right), the Assemblymember discussed the impact Al will have on all of our lives, and the role government must play to ensure this technology remains a tool for good, rather than a threat.

#### **VOLUNTARY INTOXICATION LOOPHOLE**

Alex joined survivors, advocates, and fellow legislators to advocate for the closing of the voluntary intoxication loophole; a provision of law which makes it extremely difficult to prosecute sexual assault cases where alcohol was consumed.
