

A new entrance for the NYC Ferry Line will be opening August 15th on East 90th Street. The Ferry will connect Soundview to Wall Street, making stops at 90th & 34th Streets. The ride from Soundview to Wall street should be around a 45 minute ride. Each ticket costs \$2.75.




