

Dear Neighbor,

Today marks an important turning point in the movement to stop global climate change. Student-led groups skipped class to gather in protest the denial of climate change, rollback of environmental protections, and discrediting of scientists.

As a member of the New York State Assembly, we are working to strengthen protections with the passage and signing of the Climate Community Protection Act to require the state to achieve 100% clean power by 2040 and carbon neutrality by 2050 with an 85% reduction in total greenhouse gas emissions. We allocated \$500 million for clean water infrastructure in our budget and passed critical legislation to support renewable energy sources- both wind and hydropower.

In our community, I am proud to promote green initiatives by bringing shred-a-thons to our local greenmarkets on the Upper East Side and Roosevelt Island, and by supporting GrowNYC to ensure that all New Yorkers have access to the freshest, most nutritious locally grown food. Thousands of constituents have benefited from shredding their old documents, in turn protecting their identity and responsibly disposing of old documents. 
