Seawright Cohosts Census 2020 Jobs Fairs With Manhattan Assembly Colleagues

As a member of the New York State Assembly's Manhattan Delegation, Assembly Member Seawright sponsored a series of job fairs at Pace University and Hunter College Silberman School of Social Work this week.

Every 10 years, the U.S. Census Bureau works to count every person residing in the United States. The results determine representation in all forms of government and funding, impacting all of our lives including public health, education and infrastructure.

"The fight for a fairer census has to be a united effort to achieve the goal of making sure every New Yorker and everyone in the United States is counted," said Seawright.



In previous census counts both New York State and New York City were dangerously undercounted. The 2010 Census didn't count over 50,000 New York City residents due to an error that deemed their houses vacant, and hundreds of thousands more New Yorkers were uncounted. This resulted in the loss of billions of dollars in federal funding for hospitals, public schools, transportation, emergency services, and more. The undercount resulted in New York losing two congressional seats, limiting our state's influence in federal government.
