is sponsoring a National Black History Month essay contest, with awards going to the top entries from schools in the **Upper East Side, Yorkville, and Roosevelt Island.**

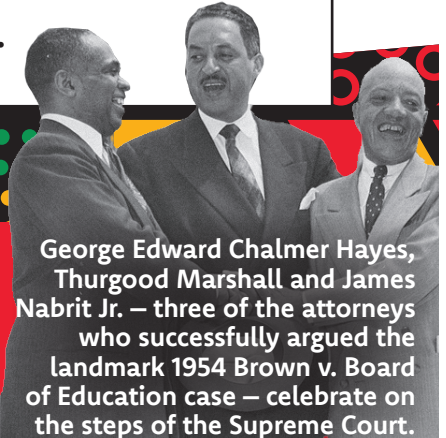
Civil rights protesters participate in the 1965 Selma to Montgomery marches.
