Investing in a brighter future

Record \$26.6 billion in education funding, nearly \$1 billion more than last year, to prepare students for a bright future

 $\sqrt{$827}$ million for pre-K programs so our youngest learners get a head start

Increased funding for public libraries to help community members of all ages access resources and learn new skills

Helping kids stay focused on learning

- \checkmark \$200 million to help high-need schools become community schools, supporting at-risk students and their families
- \checkmark \$10 million for Empire State After School awards so more students have a safe place to go when class ends
- $\sqrt{\text{Invests}}$ in Breakfast After the Bell and Farm to School programs and bans meal shaming to ensure no child is hungry at school



Putting the college dream within reach

- ✓ \$118 million for the Excelsior Scholarship, making SUNY and CUNY tuition-free for eligible students
- \checkmark \$12.1 million for SUNY and \$6.3 million for CUNY community colleges
- \checkmark Funds college opportunity programs to help disadvantaged students live up to their promise
