

NEW LAWS TAKING EFFECT – FEBRUARY 2024

Effective Date	Chapter	Summary
2/11/2024	Ch. 723 of 2023 A.2672-B S.1048-A	Requires any seller imposing a surcharge on a customer who uses a credit card to clearly and conspicuously post the total price for using a credit card and prohibits the surcharge from exceeding the amount of the surcharge charged to the business by the credit card company.
2/15/2024	Ch. 632 of 2023 A.458 S.548	Provides a deceased tenant's legal representative the option to terminate such tenant's lease upon notice to the landlord.
2/15/2024	Ch. 635 of 2023 A.2134-A S.2294-A Ch. 1 of 2024 A.8494 S.8035	Requires owners and agents of multiple residences and multiple dwellings to provide names and contact information of residents to emergency personnel upon the request of such personnel, where the physical safety of such residents must be accounted for by ascertaining their whereabouts.
2/15/2024	Ch. 651 of 2023 S.1688 A.1630	Expands the Department of Economic Development's authority to conduct market analysis, including demonstration projects, to include reuse of waste tires in agricultural settings, and to conduct an analysis of waste tire reuse opportunities.
2/15/2024	Ch. 656 of 2023 S.3255 A.501	Extends the statute of limitations for filing complaints about any alleged unlawful discriminatory practices to the New York State Division of Human Rights (DHR) from one year to three years.
2/17/2024	Ch. 511 of 2022 A.6727-A S.8746	Makes the profession of physical therapy assistant a licensed profession.

2/19/2024	Ch. 676 of 2023 A.6856 S.5487	Makes non-competitive and labor class employees subject to the same layoff provisions as competitive class employees.
2/19/2024	Ch. 732 of 2023 S.4266-A A.5088-A Ch. 12 of 2024 S.8026 A.8545	Establishes a task force on missing women and girls who are black, indigenous and people of color (BIPOC) to develop policy changes that will work to address the lack of care and concern for missing and murdered BIPOC women and girls with New York state governmental agencies.
2/20/2024	Ch.756 of 2023 S.1931-B A.7456-A	Prohibits residential and commercial properties from operating digital billboards or signs that use flashing, intermittent or moving lights near certain Mitchell-Lama housing.
2/22/2024	Ch. 539 of 2023 A.150 S.2702	Increases age for use of ATVs by minors from age 10 to 14.
2/22/2024	Ch. 588 of 2023 S.3608-A A.4987-A	Directs the Department of Health to provide a video on the dangers of drowning for infants and young children to be viewed by parents of newborn children.
2/22/2024	Ch. 604 of 2023 S.7526 A.7673-A	Authorizes construction mentoring programs for small businesses and minority and women owned enterprises in New York City.
