Assemblymember Chris Burdick: Investing in Westchester's Education

The enacted 2024-25 state budget:

- ✓ Guarantees no school district receives a Foundation Aid cut and also funds a school aid study to help **ensure funding fairness.**
- ✓ Increases school aid by **\$1.3 billion** for a total of **\$35.9 billion** statewide
- ✓ Increases Foundation Aid by **\$934.5 million** for a total of **\$24.9 billion** statewide
- ✓ Invests **\$103.9 million** statewide in public libraries to maintain these community hubs
- ✓ Delivers an additional **\$120 million** in operating and capital support for SUNY and an additional **\$80 million in operating and capital support for CUNY**
- ✓ Ensures greater access to higher education by expanding TAP eligibility for scholarships and **doubling the minimum award** per student
