



Assemblyman Slater sponsored legislation to prevent the New York State Parole Board from releasing people convicted of murdering cops before the completion of their sentence. (A.5747)

Since 2017, the Parole Board has released 41 convicted cop murderers from prison and, by the end of June, it could release two more well-known convicted murderers in the deaths of NYPD officers. (nypost.com/2023/09/16/ny-parole-board-frees-37th-cop-killer-in-6-years/)

To combat the fentanyl scourge, Assemblyman Slater wrote "Death By Dealer" legislation that would allow prosecutors to charge drug dealers with murder in overdose deaths. (A.7985)
