## Matt Slater Has A Plan To Preserve Election Integrity and Prevent Foreign Influence

Assemblyman Matt Slater is the Ranking Minority Member of the State Assembly's Election Law Committee.

To preserve the integrity of our elections and prevent foreign influence, Assemblyman Slater wrote a reform plan to stop non-citizens from voting and combat the Chinese Communist Party, recently exposed by the New York Times for using nonprofits to illegally interfere in New York elections.

## The Slater Plan includes the following:

**No Non-Citizen Voting** Slater introduced this legislation after New York City passed a local law letting non-citizens vote in city elections (A.1277).

**Voter ID** Slater's plan requires every voter to show official state or federal identification to vote (A.1927).

**Citizenship Verification** Slater would require the Board of Elections to verify the citizenship of every registered voter (A.6454).

**Foreign Donation Ban** Slater would make it illegal for politicians to take foreign donations to keep other nations from funneling campaign contributions to New York politicians (A.7852).
