INCREASED TAX INCENTIVES FOR PROVIDERS AND FAMILIES

I support the following bills to boost child tax credits:

- Increasing the Empire State child credit amount to 45% of the federal Child Tax Credit amount (A.9257)
- Creating a new Child Care Facility Capital Improvement tax credit to help child care providers enhance and update facilities (A.9264)
- Doubling the existing Child Care Creation & Expansion Tax Credit amount from \$25 million per year to \$50 million per year (A.9245)

MORE ACCESSIBLE OPTIONS FOR PARENTS AND CHILDREN

- I am supporting alternative child care solutions to be implemented into law in New York State (A.9202)

SUPPORTING FAIR ALLOCATION OF CHILD CARE RESOURCES

- I am backing a proposal that would ensure more public support is given to areas with the highest cost of living, such as Rockland County (A.9220)
