# Assemblyman Colin Schmitt: Bipartisan Environmental Legislative Update

**Preserving our Communities:** Co-sponsored and passed the expansion of the Hudson Valley Community Preservation Act for our district (A.7699-B) in the Assembly, which is critical to preserving our local communities, land, water, and natural resources.

**Protecting our Water:** Assemblyman Schmitt, member of the Assembly Minority Task Force on Water Quality, announced over \$2 million in grants through WIIP and IWWI for municipalities in his district to protect public health and improve water quality.

**Constitutional Amendment for our Environment:** Assemblyman Schmitt helped pass A.2064, a constitutional amendment guaranteeing the right to clean air and water and a healthy environment.

**Schunneunk State Park Growth:** Assemblyman Schmitt supported the addition of 158 new acres to Schunneunk State Park.

**Banning PFAS Firefighting Foam:** Assemblyman Schmitt co-sponsored and helped pass A.445-A, which greatly reduces the use of PFAS-based firefighting foam.

**Renewable Energy:** Assemblyman Schmitt has been a dedicated supporter of renewable energy to protect our environment (A.4294).

**Protecting Our Children:** Assemblyman Schmitt helped pass the Child Safe Products Act (A-6296-A) and legislation to ensure a healthier environment for our children (A. 6358).
