From his first day in office, it has been Assemblymember Eachus' top priority to reverse New York's Congestion Pricing Tax plan. Residents of Orange and Rockland counties have historically overpaid for the MTA. That's why he fought to put a stop to the proposal to charge drivers \$15 to enter Lower Manhattan.
