WHAT HOSPICE CARE IS¹

- Focuses on comfort and quality of life, not cure.
- Provides medical, emotional, and spiritual support at home, in nursing homes, or in hospice facilities

WHO QUALIFIES²

- Patients with a life expectancy of six months or less (cancer, heart/lung disease, dementia, etc.)
- A doctor's certification is required but anyone can request an evaluation

WHAT HOSPICE PROVIDES³

- Expert pain and symptom management
- 24/7 nurse availability
- Medications, supplies, and equipment
- Counseling and grief support for families

HOW IT'S PAID FOR¹

- ♦ Covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurance
- No out-of-pocket costs for most families

WHEN TO BEGIN HOSPICE

 Early enrollment improves comfort, caregiver support, and quality of time together

HOSPICE VS. PALLIATIVE CARE⁵

- Palliative Care: For any stage of illness, even during treatment
- Hospice Care: For when treatment is no longer effective or desired

PREPARING AHEAD

- Complete advance directives
- Discuss care preferences (home or facility)
- Identify support networks
