

Assemblymember Barrett leads on climate-smart agriculture

By introducing the **Carbon Farming Act** (A.3281) this year, Assemblymember Didi Barrett has helped position New York State to become the first in the country to create a **tax credit program for farmers who use climate-smart agricultural strategies**. Many of these practices – no-till or use of cover crops among them – are time-honored and have been in regular use by some local farmers because they create more resilient and productive soil. But they also can help New York reach our climate goals of significantly reducing greenhouse gases by removing carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and storing it in the soil.

This bill creates a carrot rather than stick approach that would support farms of any size that engage in climate-smart agriculture. To help create this pioneering tax credit, the 2017-18 New York State budget has allocated funding to study the best ways to measure and quantify carbon storage and change.
