Here in the Hudson Valley, we are fortunate to be neighbors with many small and midsize family-owned farms and producers that provide fresh, local food to our communities. Late spring marks the return of our beloved and bountiful community farmers markets, which support local businesses and expand access to fresh, healthy, local foods to everyone.

Our recently passed 2023–24 state budget increases funding for programs supporting local farmers and families' food security. This includes \$50 million for Nourish NY, a program that helps farmers sell their surplus crops to feed New Yorkers in need. Another \$2 million will go to the New York State Farm Viability Institute, which provides grants to make farms more productive, profitable, and sustainable.

When we support our local farms and farmers, our whole community benefits. The Hudson Valley's network of small and midsize family-owned farms is crucial to our local and our state's economy. I hope to see you at a farmers market this summer. Shop local!
