

is helping build a brighter future for Hudson Valley families

The enacted 2024-25 state budget supports critical local projects, including:

✓ Over \$500 million in state aid to schools across the 106th Assembly District, ensuring every student can get the quality education they deserve



- √ \$2 million to safely close the New Lebanon landfill
- √ \$400,000 to provide transportation and child care services to clean energy preapprenticeship participants, promoting workforce development in our green economy
- √ \$300,000 for Dutchess Community College to alleviate housing and food insecurity for students
- √ \$200,000 for a shuttle service between Hudson and Chatham, helping fill
 a major transit gap that will allow residents to easily travel for work, medical
 appointments, shopping and recreation

Assemblymember Barrett has delivered on these cost-saving measures:

- √ \$500 million for clean water infrastructure and more than \$800 million for critical road improvements
- √ \$54 million for Nourish NY to connect struggling farmers with food-insecure households
- √ \$40 million for the Homeowner Protection Program (HOPP), \$50 million for Eviction Prevention Legal Services, and new incentives to create more affordable housing in upstate New York
- √ \$2 million for the Public Utility Law Project (PULP), a consumer advocacy agency that provides information and legal assistance to low-income residents
