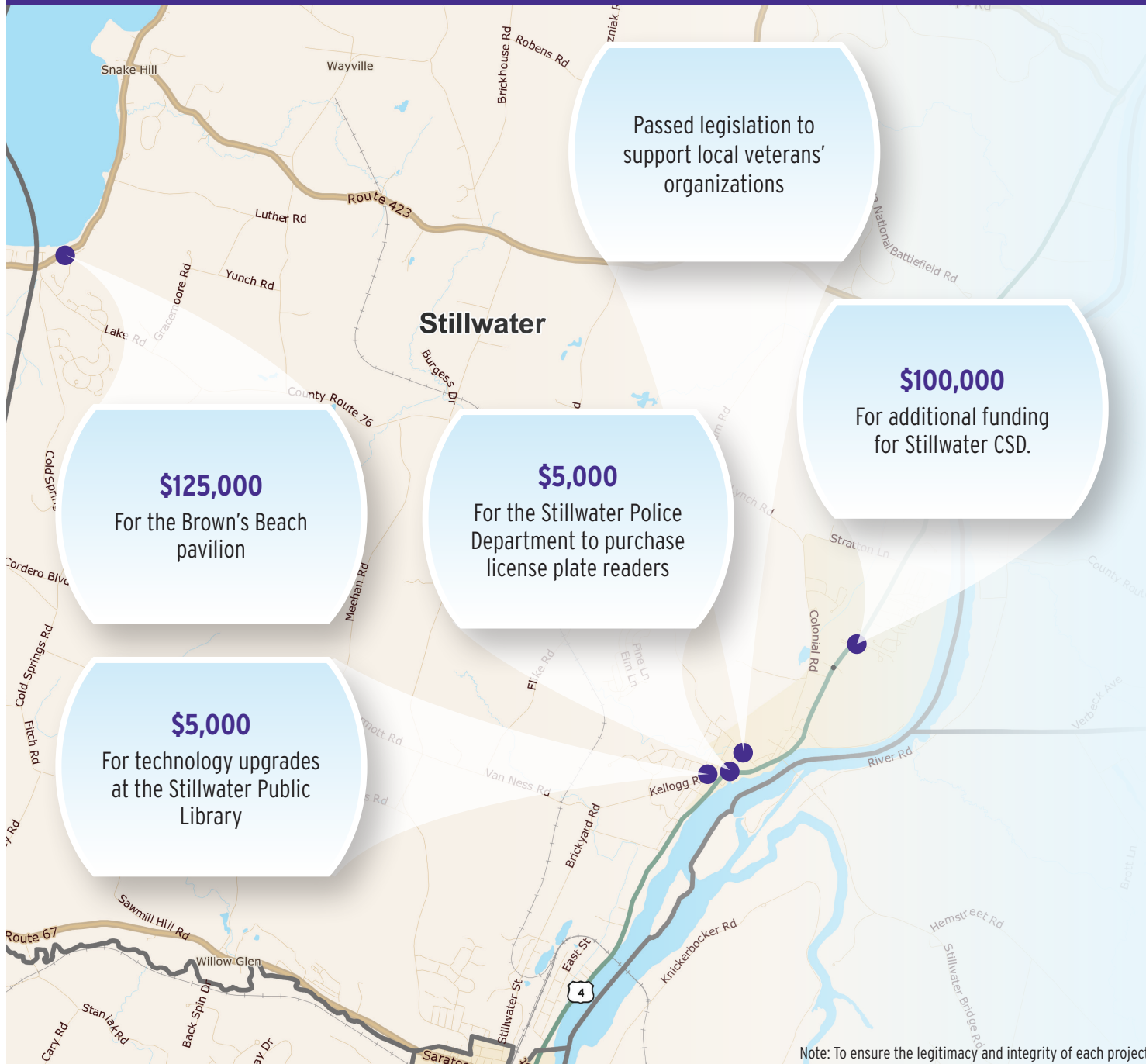

## Building up our communities

- Secured \$125,000 to construct a pavilion at Brown's Beach to give Stillwater families and visitors a place to come together and enjoy Saratoga Lake
- Secured \$5,000 to upgrade technology at the Stillwater Public Library to ensure local residents can continue enjoying this vital community resource

## Looking out for our families

To help ensure Stillwater and area residents receive top-notch care during an emergency, Assemblywoman Woerner helped provide \$10,000 for the Malta-Stillwater EMS for upgrades to patient care in 2018.



## Supporting local veterans

Veterans' organizations are vital to helping ensure that those who served our country have a place to gather with fellow veterans. That's why Assemblywoman Woerner sponsored and passed legislation allowing Washington and Saratoga counties to waive certain fees for veterans organizations to help avoid imposing increased membership fees on members in cases of building construction or improvements (Ch. 483 of 2019).

## Strengthening Stillwater schools

Throughout her time in the Assembly, Assemblywoman Woerner has worked hard to secure funding so that local school districts can continue giving students in the 113th Assembly District a quality education. To that end, Assemblywoman Woerner helped provide \$100,000 in additional funding for the Stillwater Central School District.

## Protecting the public

To help the Stillwater Police Department keep the local community safe, Assemblywoman Woerner helped secure \$5,000 for the department to purchase new license plate readers.
