The 2026-27 state budget she helped pass:



Delivers one-time
**Protecting Our
Wallets Energy Rebate
(POWER)** checks
of up to \$200 and
**establishes the
RATES Commission**
to help lower costs



Enhances the
**Child and Dependent
Care Credit** and
**eliminates income
taxes** on qualified
tipped wages up
to \$25,000



**Lowers car insurance
premiums** by cracking
down on fraud and
abuse while requiring
excess business profits
to be returned to
policyholders



**Provides \$3 billion
for childcare assistance,**
**expands access to free
tuition** for more students,
provides \$4.4 million
more in Foundation Aid
than last year for AD 113
and a **\$1.7 million** increase
in library aid statewide



**Invests in local
government assistance,**
including over **\$1.4
million** in Temporary
Municipal Aid and **\$4.2
million** in CHIPs funding
for AD 113, ensuring
continued access to
essential services
