
TWPORTANT DETATES ON THE STATE TNSIDE!

Like all budgets, the state budget the Legislature passed contained both good and bad. Unfortunately, I had to vote **no** due to the bad greatly outweighing any good included within.

The BAD included:

- More than \$2 billion to migrants in New York City (A.8803-D)
- No meaningful change to bail reform
- No reduction in taxes for the middle class
- **Prison closures** with only a 90-day notice (A.8805-C)
- **Removal of local control** for the siting and routing of transmission lines that will reroute electricity from upstate to New York City (A.8808-C)
- **No increase in funding** to upkeep and improve our local roads and bridges (A.8804-D)
- **No repeal** of tax credits for Hollywood elites
