

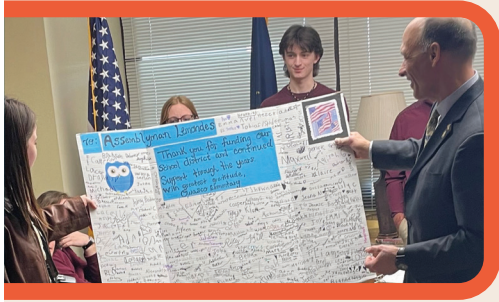

- ✔ Established a youth development agriculture technology challenge to get students involved in local agriculture (A.1528)
- ✔ Promote “Back to Basics” plan to improve reading proficiency
