

"The United Nations General Assembly designated January 27—the anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau—as International Holocaust Remembrance Day. On this annual day of commemoration, the UN urges every member state to honor the six million Jewish victims of the Holocaust and millions of other victims of Nazism and to develop educational programs to help prevent future genocides."

<u>Today and everyday, may we remember</u> <u>the victims of the Holocaust.</u> As a new legislative session starts my primary focus will be revitalizing the economy and protecting public health for CNY families.

Much of our annual state budget this year relies on the amount of aid we will be receiving from the federal government. No matter what happens in Washington D.C., I am committed to fighting against harmful cuts to education and our essential services.

Low income families have suffered disproportionately from this pandemic and deserve an equitable distribution of any assistance that can be provided.

While much of the focus will be on the state budget and rent relief over the next two months, *I am still* actively pursuing my legislative priorities that protects tenants, assists small businesses and seeks criminal justice reform. With a new legislative session, all of my bills have been renumbered.


