Dear Legislative Leaders,

We are writing to request that expanded hunting and crossbow licensing be included in the final budget. The Governor's executive budget proposal included lowering the hunting age limit to 12 years old and expanding the use of crossbows in all big-game and small-game hunting seasons in which other bowhunting equipment is allowed. However, these proposals were removed from the recently introduced Assembly and Senate one house budgets.

As the deer population in New York continues to grow, hunting provides an effective way to manage the herd. Currently, New York State is the only state in the nation that has not lowered its big game hunting age limit to 12 years old or younger. The average age of individuals purchasing a sporting license is 50 years old. Recruiting young hunters is extremely important to the longevity of hunting in New York, ensuring that the deer herd can be managed through hunting for generations to come.

Recently, the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) released a draft 10 Year Deer Management Plan which recommended allowing the DEC to regulate crossbow usage to manage deer herds. This recommendation is supported by many sportsmen because it increases accessibility to hunting. Many hunters are physically unable to operate a bow, putting them at a disadvantage during the current bow season. By classifying crossbows as archery equipment, it would allow their use in deer hunting when archery is allowed and increase accessibility to those with physical limitations.

Thank you for your consideration on this important issue. We are hopeful these measures will be put forth in the final budget this year.
